REFLECTIONS OF THE PAST

In these painting classes we feature uniquely designed projects taught using our own 50/50 techniques. Yes...you can do this! The basic elements are applied using stencils that you will use in class. The amount of detail added will depend on your painting experience or your willingness to try! Most projects suitable for beginners, too! You will be hooked! (and you'll leave with a finished project...one you'll be proud of.)

MOST PIECES REQUIRE PREPARATION BEFORE CLASS!

Bring to class: Waxed palette paper, paper towels, masking tape, chalk pencil, kneaded eraser, sanding disc, 2" sponge brush, liner brush and required stencil brushes (may be purchased in class). Some classes will require additional supplies.

Fieldstone Farm - Paint a 20" x 30" canvas farm scene and wood grain a frame to surround it! Frame and canvas included. PREP needed. Bring lunch! 2 weeks

REMINDERS

End of Bolt Sale - Don't forget our ongoing "End of the Bolt Sale" on the last business day of each month. You will receive 25% off your fabric if you purchase the whole bolt! Come in and find those skinny bolts.

ALERT - PARKING - When the store next to us is open...Please park in the spaces in front of our store or along the left hill.
